See Alison deceiving — by Royal appointment

SEEING is deceiving is the theme of Alison Jackson's new show and last night the artist made an appearance in front of her works at Hamilton's Gallery in Mayfair.

Jackson, pictured left, sets up mock-up photographs of celebrities in compromising positions. Here she is posing in front of a fake Prince William having the word "King" scrawled on his chest by a female fan. A Prince Philip lookalike is shown

admiring pornographic pictures in another creation. Jackson was spotted chatting to ITV's head of global content Dawn Airey — can we expect a Jackson show to transfer to ITV soon?

Gallery director Tim Jefferies was present with Scandinavian fiancée Malin Johansson (above). London's answer to Warren Beatty has yet to be cast in a Jackson montage. There's still time though, Tim.
