The Chelsea art gallery scene gets back into full swing this week, and many good shows beckon. Among them is one of black-and-white photographs from the 1970s by the Japanese photographer KOHEI YOSHIYUKI at the Yossi Milo Gallery. Taken in parks, using infrared film and a flash, they document a bizarre ritual: young Japanese couples who gathered there at night for romantic trysts, as well as the numerous spectators hiding in the nearby bushes who liked to watch.
